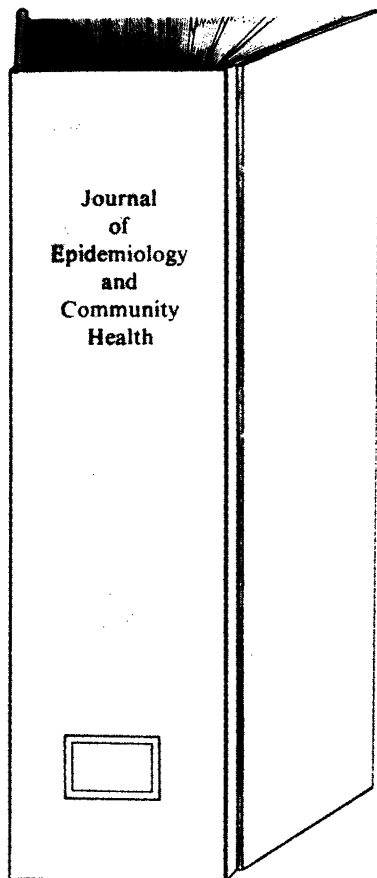

In the past few years, there has been a remarkable increase in our understanding of the toxicology of nickel and its compounds. A Conference was convened in Swansea by a Subcommittee of the I.U.P.A.C. Commission on Toxicology, Division of Clinical Chemistry, to bring together many of the world's experts on the characterisation and trace analysis of nickel, and on its metabolism, toxicology, pharmacology, epidemiology and its role in occupational medicine.

This book provides the reader with a rapid publication of the results of current research on important aspects of nickel toxicology and gives a broad and balanced perspective of the chemistry and biology of nickel, which is both authoritative and up-to-date. It will be of special interest to toxicologists, cancer epidemiologists and occupational physicians and hygienists, to industrial and governmental agencies concerned with nickel manufacture and processing; and to biochemists, nutritionists and pharmacologists who work with trace metals.
