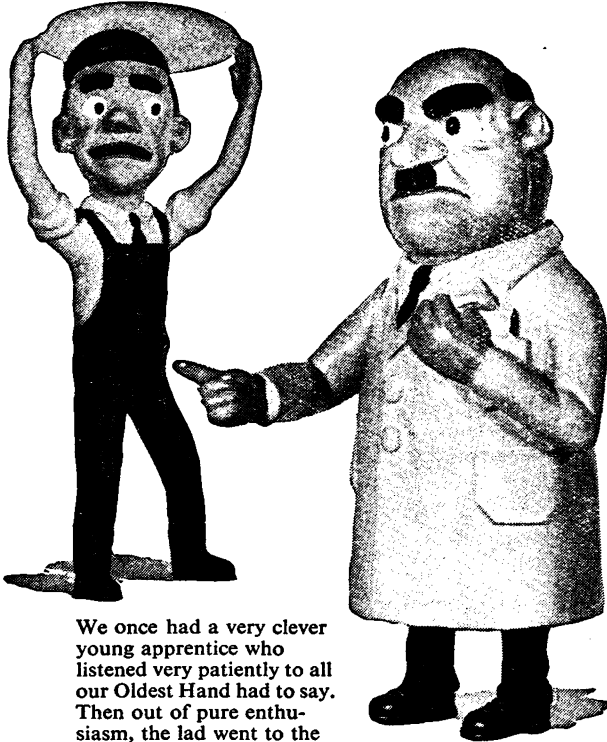


Hexachlorophene halo
