Although the journal will be mainly concerned with human genetics, occasional animal studies will be published where they are relevant. In addition, authoritative review articles will appear at fairly regular intervals.

The first quarterly number of this Journal will be published September 1964. In the first volume there will be two numbers (September and December). In subsequent volumes, starting in 1965, there will be four numbers published in March, June, September and December. Each issue will contain some 70 pages of text.
