The Christie Hospital has acquired a high reputation for its many publications on statistical studies to evaluate different methods of treating cancer in many different guises and different anatomical sites. This volume differs from previous publications from this hospital in that it examines the fate of cancer patients over 15 years following appropriate treatment. This long follow-up period provides an opportunity to examine the feasibility of permanent cure of this disease. Chapters have been devoted to malignant disease of each of the anatomical sites most frequently treated by radiotherapy, alone or in combination with surgery. Full coverage is given to most head and neck tumours, to breast, uterus, ovary, testis, genito-urinary system, skin, and the lymphatics. Each chapter contains information about the incidence of the particular tumour, its histological pattern, the main presenting symptoms, the preferred techniques of treatment, and then the follow-up results.
