It is the policy of this Journal to publish original work in the field of epidemiology and community health which relates to a total defined population and which shall be numerically rated. The field of interest includes studies of the distribution and behaviour of disease in human populations; the definition of the agents responsible for the patterns observed; the modifying effect of social or environmental conditions on disease evolution; and the assessment of the health and efficiency of people exposed to various external circumstances. Linked with these subjects is the design of measures intended to control or prevent disease and the field assessment of their value in public health practice. Epidemiology and community health also encompasses the objective study of the organisation and functioning of medical services with particular emphasis on the measurement of their effectiveness and efficiency. Papers are accepted on their scientific originality and general interest, and ethical considerations will be taken into account.

**COMMUNICATIONS** Papers should be prepared in accordance with the uniform requirements for manuscripts submitted to biomedical journals, *Br Med J* 1988; **296**: 401-5. Two copies should be submitted to the Editor, *Journal of Epidemiology and Community Health*, Department of Epidemiology and Public Health, University of Bristol, Canynge Hall, Whiteladies Road, Bristol BS8 2PR. Papers will be considered in accordance with the terms of the uniform requirements. Papers will be acknowledged if a stamped addressed envelope or an international postal coupon is enclosed. Papers will not be returned whether accepted or not, so copies should be retained by authors. Abstracts, Tables, Acknowledgments, References should be in accordance with the uniform requirements for manuscripts. Abstracts should be kept within 250 words length and should be structured (see "A proposal for more informative abstracts of clinical articles", *Ann Int Med* 1987; **106**: 596-604). Figures and illustrations will be redrawn, where appropriate, by the Art department at the British Medical Journal to ensure uniform style, so glossy prints are not required except for photomicrographs or other photographic illustrations. References will not be checked by the editorial office, as responsibility for the accuracy and completeness lies with the author.

**PROOFS** Contributors will receive one proof, and should read it carefully for printers' errors, and check the tables, figures, legends, and any numerical, mathematical, or other scientific expressions. Alterations to the original text should be kept to a minimum.

**REPRINTS** Reprints may be ordered from the Publishing Manager when the proofs are returned.
