

## Appendix: Exposure to risk situations while in theatre

Were you in contact with:	Gulf	Bosnia	Kosov
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Smoke from oil well fires			
Exhaust from heaters or generators (e.g. kerosene heaters)			
Diesel and/or other petrochemical fumes			
Diesel or other petrochemical fuel <i>on your skin</i>			
Burning rubbish or faeces			
CARC (Chemical Agent Resistant Compound) paint			
Other paints, solvents, or petrochemical substances			
Personal pesticides (e.g. creams, sprays, or flea collars)			
Pesticides on your clothing or bedding			
Chemical/Nerve gas attack			
Mustard gas or other blistering agents			
Food contaminated with smoke, oil, or other chemicals			
Local food other than food provided by the Armed Forces			
Dead animals			
Bathe in or drink water contaminated with smoke, oil, or other chemicals			
Bathe or swim in the local pond, or river			
Suffer from heat cramps, heat exhaustion, heat stroke, or other heat illnesses			
Suffer a combat related injury that required medical attention during your deployment			
See any dismembered, burnt or otherwise disfigured bodies			

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See any maimed or seriously injured soldiers

Witness anyone dying

Wear NBC suits

Have a SCUD missile explode in the air or on the ground  
within one mile of you



Have artillery, rockets, mortars, or anything else, other than  
SCUD missiles, explode in the air or on the ground close to  
you

Come under small arms fire

Hear chemical alarms sounding



Handle or come into contact with POWs/displaced refugees

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
